LETTER TO THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION ON BEHALF OF EUROPE'S CULTURAL AND CREATIVE SECTORS

"Open letter by a pan-European community of 110 networks and associations, aiming to call on the European Commission to encourage Member States to fully integrate culture in their national recovery and resilience plans, allocating at the very least 2% of the RRF budgets to the CCS"
